

JP Online – new security measures

On Monday 3 July, important security updates will be introduced to JP Online.

These include the introduction of two-factor authentication, CAPTCHA and account timeout features.

These enhancements will affect the way you next log in to JP Online, and change how you log in when you have entered an incorrect password.

Two-factor authentication

When you next log in to JP Online, you will be prompted to enable two-factor authentication by resetting your password. We encourage you to log in as soon as possible after 3 July.

Please see below a step-by-step guide on how to reset your password.

Step 1: go to log in to page

Go to the JP Online log in page.

Enter your username and current password.

Click Log in.

Step 2: retrieve security code

A unique verification code will be sent to your registered email address.

Copy or write down the code that was sent to you via email. (Do not close the JP Online log in page.)

Step 3: enter the security code

Return to the JP Online log in page and enter the code in the verification code field.

Click Submit.

Step 4: create a new password

You will now be prompted to create a new password for your JP Online account. Enter the new password in the **New Password** field.

Make sure you follow the password requirements. Passwords for JP Online require at least:

- 10 characters
- 1 lowercase character
- 1 uppercase character
- 1 numerical character (1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 9)
- 1 special character (!@#\$^)

Re-type the new password in the **Confirm Password** field.

Click Change Password.

Step 5: password change successful

Provided you have met the password requirements and the new passwords entered match, the following screen will appear confirming that you have successfully changed your password.

You can then click **Continue to login** to access JP Online.

CAPTCHA and account timeout

If you enter an incorrect password when you next attempt to log in to JP Online, you will be prompted to enter a CAPTCHA. This is a randomly generated sequence of letters and numbers that will appear on screen.

After four incorrect password attempts, your account will lock for 30 minutes. You must wait for this time to pass before you can attempt to log in again or reset your password.

Below is an example of what a CAPTCHA will look like. Copy the sequence of characters and numbers in the field directly below after entering your email and password. Then, click **Log in**.

Account timeout

After four repeated incorrect login attempts, your account will lock for 30 minutes. (See pictured below in red.)

You must wait for this time to pass before you can attempt to log in again or reset your password.
